BEHAVIORAL HEALTH INTERVENTION SERVICES AND

MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES LSI's expert therapists provide mental health care, in-person and virtually, to children, couples, families, and adults on a flexible schedule that meets each client's needs.

LSI Behavioral Health Intervention Services social workers provide regular in-home visits to children with severe emotional or behavioral disorders, providing families with activities and tips to improve healthy communication, anger management, and decision-making.

EARLY CHILDHOOD SERVICES LSI parent educators empower parents and expecting parents through in-home visits and education to ensure children are hitting their developmental milestones.

They also connect families to resources like parenting support groups and community supports like affordable housing, local food pantries, and career development programming.

SERVICES FOR PEOPLE WITH DISABILITIES

LSI walks alongside lowans with disabilities as they build their independence. Our Services for People with Disabilities provide a range of service, from occasional respite care, to direct support professionals offering 24-7 supervision or hourly care.

LSI's newest program, Host Homes, provides an innovative shared living opportunity for adults with disabilities, who may thrive in a private family home with more one-on-one support from an LSI independent contractor.

FOSTER CARE AND ADOPTION In 30 western Iowa counties, LSI Foster Care and Adoption recruits, licenses, and supports foster and adoptive parents to ensure every child has a healthy support system.

LSI's recruiters provide initial orientations for families, guide them through the licensing and training process, and serve as a shoulder to lean on for foster and adoptive families.

IMMIGRANT AND REFUGEE COMMUNITY SERVICES

lowa has a long legacy of welcoming former refugees and immigrants as they build their new lives in the U.S.

LSI's Refugee and Immigrant Services team empowers and supports families by providing education, family wellness, and career development programming.

RESIDENTIAL TREATMENT LSI's Bremwood Residential Treatment Center campus in Waverly provides 24-hour mental health treatment for some of lowa's most vulnerable children and teens.


